

2013 Summer School Information

According to the NYC Department of Education - summer school provides students with additional instructional support to ensure that they achieve proficiency in NYS Learning Standards and NYC Performance Standards in order to move on to the next grade level. Summer school is encouraged for those students in grades 3-12 who have not yet met the promotion standards to move on to the next grade level. Individual schools administer summer school. If you have a question about whether your child should attend summer school, please contact the principal at your child's school.
